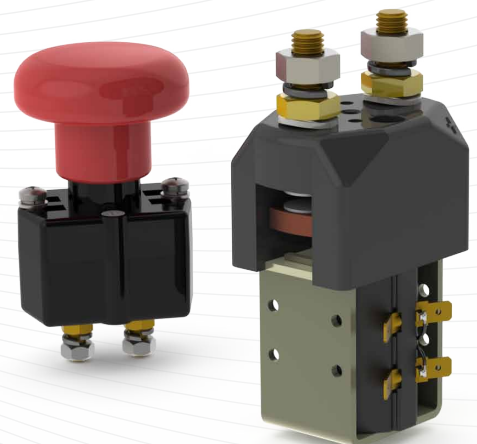

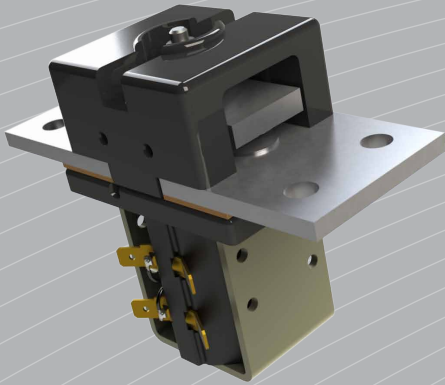

## Albright Organisation

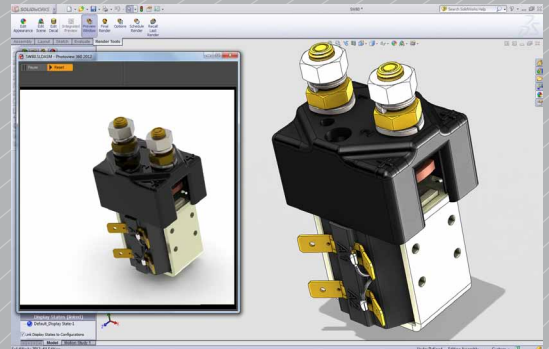
