This Policy reflects Albright International's assessment of the current risks and business opportunities to our Company as a whole based on legal and regulatory requirements, our reputation, and our obligations as a corporate citizen.

As a result Albright International legal entities, wherever they are located, should not accept any business (including new orders from existing customers or the submission of new bids) in and with these countries.

Albright International companies comply with US, EU and other international trade laws and will continue to comply with all such laws.
