CONFLICT MINERALS ORIGINATING FROM THE DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO (DRC).

Albright (all subsidiaries) are committed to supporting: Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wallstreet Reform and Customer Protection Act, the landmark US law requiring U.S. publicly listed companies to responsibly source minerals, including tin, tungsten, tantalum, and gold, that might originate in the Democratic Republic of the Congo and adjoining countries.

We are also committed to supporting: Regulation (EU) 2017/821 of The European Parliament and of the Council, of 17 May 2017, laying down supply chain due diligence obligations for Union importers of tin, tantalum and tungsten, their ores, and gold originating from conflict-affected and high-risk areas.

We have therefore taken steps to ensure suppliers of processes and products in which certain conflict minerals necessary for their functionality or production have been assessed and declarations sought that show compliance to the Dodd-Frank act and follow the intent of the European regulations. Conflict minerals include coltan (tantalum), cassiterite (tin), wolframite (tungsten) and gold any other mineral or derivative determined by the US Secretary of State.

We expect the suppliers to comply with the Electronic Industry Code of Conduct and to only source materials and products from environmentally and socially responsible suppliers.

We ask our suppliers to:

1. Comply with all national and other applicable laws and regulations concerning the sourcing of minerals from conflict or high-risk areas
2. Not use conflict minerals originating in the Democratic Republic Congo and its adjoining countries.
3. Use the latest Conflict Minerals Reporting Template, published by the Responsible Minerals Initiative to disclose their supply chain of said materials to enable us to fulfil our reporting obligations.
